## Beaverhill Bird Observatory

Weekly Update – May 22-28, 2025



Migration Monitoring really picked up this week. Least Flycatchers, Yellow Warblers, and Clay-coloured Sparrows were the most frequently captured species, as they move into the breeding season. This week also saw an increase in captured Baltimore Orioles, which is always a welcome sight! Fun captures included a Rose-breasted Grosbeak, a Philadelphia Vireo, and a Sharp-shinned Hawk.

**Baltimore Oriole** 

Spring migration so far has been building slowly and steadily, with 34 total species captured so far. We accomplished our highest captures this week, with 52 birds on May 23rd.

While most of our captures have been local breeding birds, busy days are still exciting. In total this week, we caught 255 birds in 605 net hours.

Staff this week completed surveys, including Marsh Monitoring and Least Flycatcher nest monitoring surveys. They also continued trail maintenance and repairs on nets and other equipment.

Staff and volunteers welcomed two school groups and hosted two songbird banding events, making the week busy for both events and banding!
