The Beaverhill Bird Observatory (BBO) is the oldest bird observatory in western Canada and has been monitoring the local breeding and migratory birds since 1984. The BBO conducts research focused on monitoring bird populations and environmental education.

In the winter months, BBO runs our BirdSmart Education Program where staff bring a live educational bird of prey to give presentations about birds, conservation, and climate change to schools, daycares, after-school groups, senior's residences, and private and other events.

Most presentations include information on how to protect birds in local communities and how to reduce your impacts on climate change.



Each presentation is designed to suit each grade level, and meet specific learning objectives in the Alberta science curriculum.

Interactions with the Educational Birds

All presentations include one of the educational birds. We have a Red-tailed Hawk (Keith), a Greathorned Owl (Tansi), a Burrowing Owl (Nina), and a Prairie Falcon (Kali) on the education team!

Supplementary Materials

All presentations also include supplementary activities such as word searches and crosswords appropriate to the grade level.
